Good Afternoon WB Families:

Well we have 7 days in for the 2020-2021 school year. We will need to be happy with celebrating small achievements this year and this milestone is our first goal met. As we move into next week, there are several updates to share with you today. As always, our plans continue to be fluid and are subject to change based on new mandates, local COVID-19 data and/or district needs.

## Food Service

We are very excited to share with you that the USDA has expanded the Seamless Summer Option (SSO) program. This is the program that West Branch accessed March through June to provide free meals to interested students. With this week's announcement of the program extension, West Branch is eligible to re-access this program immediately. What does this mean for our families? **Effective Tuesday, September 8, 2020 all WB students can have a free breakfast and lunch each day as long as the program remains open.** This offer applies to all WB in-house and cyber students as well as any children in the community ages 2-18. The extension is currently set to expire on December 31, 2020 or when funds are exhausted. Regardless, your children can eat free until that time. For those folks with children at home, you will be able to receive your free meals via our drive-thru each Tuesday and Friday. ## **School Athletics**

This week, Governor Wolf revised the guidance pertaining to spectators at school sporting events to align with the Order pertaining to Mass Gatherings. As such, we are now governed by a 250 limit (outside events) and 25 limit (inside events). I would remind you that this does include the student participants, coaches, officials, media, event staff and spectators. Given that the number of 250 and 25 are inclusive of every individual, this does present relief for some sports but not for others. There is additionally a House Bill moving through the two chambers which would provide some additional spectator relief.

As we move through the next week or so and await final guidance from Harrisburg, we will be handling our events a week at a time. Following is next week's schedule:
